

Yellow fever vaccination certificate - Advisory

Yellow fever vaccination certificate is a health requirement for all arriving travellers.

Yellow fever requirements

- All travellers arriving in Kenya from countries where yellow fever is endemic should present a valid yellow fever certificate.

Yellow Fever Vaccination exemptions

- Infants aged less than 9 months, except during an epidemic when infants aged 6-9 months, in areas where the risk of infection is high, should also receive the vaccine.
- Pregnant women – except during a yellow fever outbreak when the risk of infection is high.
- People with severe allergies to egg protein.
- People with severe immunodeficiency due to symptomatic HIV/AIDS or other causes, or who have a thymus disorder.
